Preliminary Exam Result

It helped students to evaluate their preparation and assess their weak areas. Papers were reviewed by students on the 24th February, 2020.

A PTM was organized to announce the result of Preliminary Examination on Saturday, 29th February, 2020 and all parents were requested to review the result in which parents were informed about their child's progress in detail. It was an excursion integrated with other subjects where our students could relate to what they saw with diversified subjects.

As we entered the planetarium it was full of surprises to see a big plane at the entrance. There we saw a movie on galaxies and milky ways and gained profound knowledge on different planets, moons, distance of solar bodies from the sun, dwarf planet, comets and lots more. Right after, it was time to board the plane and enjoy safety measures during a flight or in case of an emergency by a trained crew member. At the exit students got a chance to sit in the cockpit and explore the control room of the pilot. The trip was interesting and engaging. The students were able to relate this trip to their Social Studies, Math, Science and Languages Subjects. This trip further boosted the assimilation of one subject to another. On our way back students were given feedback forms to evaluate what they already knew, what they learnt after the tour and what they are eager to know in future.



Baking Class

Teaching life-long skills is an integral part of curriculum. GIFS ensures to adorn its students with all the pragmatic skills. For this purpose, students of Class VII were taken to Green Island Women Wings on 26th February, 2020, for the erudition of culinary art skills. 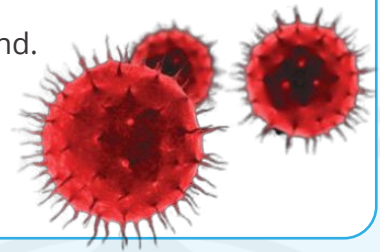
Covid-19: A Dangerous Virus

INTERESTING VOYAGE TO TRITON (Moon)

I was shocked that how is it possible that the most chosen job is the job of ASTRONAUT, but after a little research I got to know that this is the most interesting field because outer space is just like another world which might have no limits. Holy prophet (s.a.w.w.) said,

“Seeking knowledge is compulsory on every Muslim.”

“Wisdom is the lost property of the believer.”

“Whoever follows a path seeking knowledge, Allah will make his path to paradise easy.”

Therefore, it means that we should learn about every single beauty of nature and the most beautiful, limitless beauty of nature is outer space. There are moons, sun, planets, stars, galaxies. In front of all this Earth is just a dot or less than a dot.

Keeping the view of importance of space I would like to enlighten that there are approximately 200 moons in our solar system. Let me illuminate that the moon of Neptune (TRITON) is the most interesting moon as compared to the moon of Uranus (MIRANDA) and the moon of dwarf planet Pluto (CHARON).

TRITON, the moon of Neptune is the largest natural satellite of the planet Neptune, and the first Neptunian moon to be discovered. The discovery was made on October 10, 1846, by English astronomer William Lassell. It is the only large moon in the solar system with a retrograde orbit, an orbit in the direction opposite to its planet's rotation. At 2,710 kilometers (1,680 mi) in diameter, it is the seventh-largest moon in the Solar System.

It is covered by a transparent layer of annealed frozen nitrogen and only 40% of the surface is discovered. If water was present in Triton, it has been speculated that this could make it habitable for some form of life.

Triton has a tenuous nitrogen atmosphere, with trace amounts of carbon monoxide and small amounts of methane near its surface.

Considering the above research it inclines me to visit Triton, as this is the only moon which is discovered about only 40% which includes methane and carbon monoxide. Methane is used for refueling rocket, and can be used as a fuel for ovens, water heaters, kilns, automobiles, turbines etc. Whereas, carbon monoxide is used in a variety of industries for a wide range of applications including Metal Fabrication. Else we can find many things there, if we send an aircraft to the TRITON. I hope that we will be able to find water, oxygen etc.
