PUNCTUALITY

What a pleasing sight it was!!! At the recent Annual Day celebrations of Green Island Foundation School where students performing were already on stage few minutes before the mentioned time of the program waiting for the clock to strike so the first performances could begin. And if this wasn't enough to make a lasting impression, the two programs, each spanning around 3 hours and exhibiting 300+ performers aged between 2 and 16 didn't go into overtime even by a single minute. This exhibition of punctuality was a World Class performance in itself by any standards.

Punctuality is indeed a very important trait that we need to teach our children while preparing them for their future and there is no better way to teach it than to practice it ourselves. We cannot expect our children to be successful in their personal and professional lives without being punctual. All great people, be it religious, political, social, entrepreneurs and visionaries have practiced punctuality throughout their lives. For this very reason, all great institutions enforce punctuality as well. As a matter of fact in the modern world you can't keep turning up late in day to day activities and expect not to lose out.

As a parent it really hurts when the GIFS management informed the PTA forum about 10% of the students are turning up late every morning for school. According to the management few are occasional, but a lot of them are habitual and regular. It really hurts to know that a model institution like GIFS which practices punctuality in its true spirit is facing this late comers' issue. I genuinely believe that the question here is not who's at fault rather whose responsibility it is that our children reach school on time regularly? As parents we should all know the answer!!

To emphasize the importance of punctuality let me narrate a real life example from my student life, to our dear children and fellow parents. I used to study at IBA and as per policy we were allowed only 4 absence per semester. Once the Director's son, who was also studying there had to undergo an immediate surgery at OMI hospital across the road. As per policy he was also allowed the usual four absence and on the fifth day he had a choice of either somehow managing to get to the institute on time or risk failing that semester. Even being the Director's son or being at the hospital didn't warrant any special treatment for Mudassar. As expected, he turned up on the 5th morning in a wheel chair in time for the attendance!

My dear friends, punctuality is a pre requisite for success. It is not just about being on time. It is about respecting your own commitments! Let's commit to ensure punctuality of our children because after all it is our responsibility!!
