Rules, Regulations & Specifications

- Entries must be in English. All manuscripts must be handwritten on a white A4 size paper only. Each page must be consecutively numbered. No previously published work may be submitted. Work must be original. Any borrowed ideas or language must be appropriately acknowledged.
- The name of the contestant SHOULD NOT appear on the manuscript. A duly filled Participant Submission Form must accompany each entry.
- Any writing under suspicion of plagiarism will be disqualified.
- Entries will not be returned. Please make a copy of your entry before submitting it.
- Students may use any source of inspiration for their writing, including nature, people, sports teams, places, books, cartoons, and more. The piece of writing can take any form, including a poem, fact sheet, newspaper article, or any other kind of writing.

Evaluation Criteria:

Content and Body (maximum 40 points), Sentence Formation (maximum 20 points), Style (maximum 20 points), Creativity (maximum 20 points).

Words Limit:

Grade 1 & 2:	20-30 words
Grade 3 & 4:	50-60 words
Grade 5 & 6:	80-100 words
Grade 7 & 8:	120-150 words
Grade 9 & 10:	200-250 words
