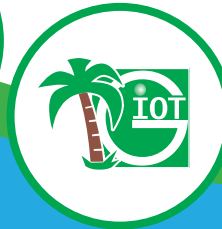

- Adding smiles and numbers—our little learners enjoyed their first addition lesson. Students practiced adding numbers using colorful objects and hands-on counting games.

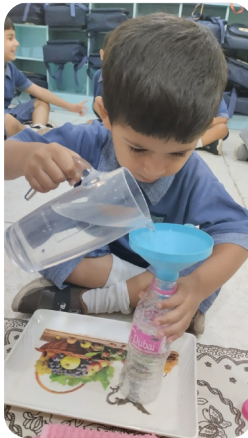
ECD IV

- Using scissors and funnels helped the children experience everyday life skills through engaging and enjoyable activities.



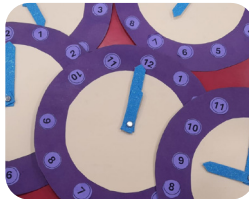
Zigzag Activity (ECD I)

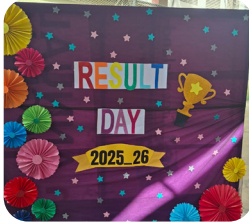


Final Assessments and Observations

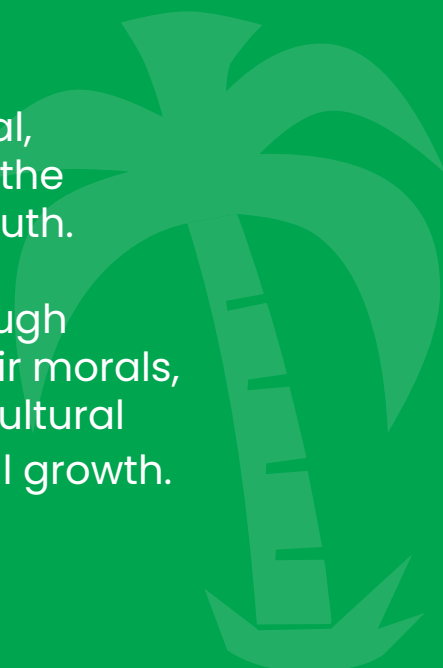

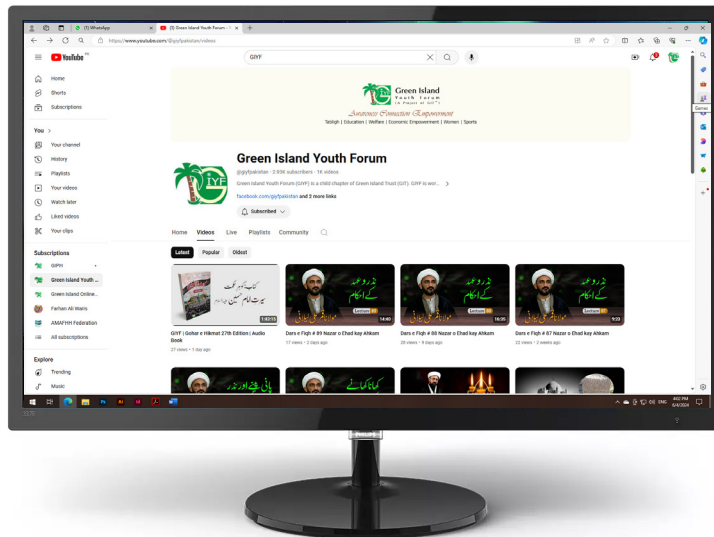

Online Lectures

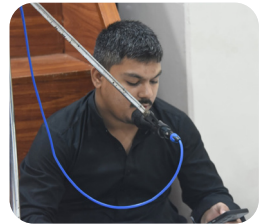

 - **Masaib-e-Karbala kay pehlay Shaheed, Muslim Ibn-e-Aqeel (a.s.)**





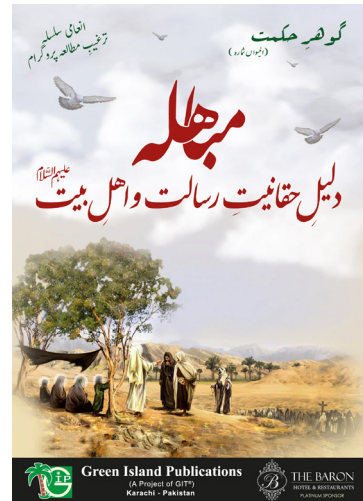
Monthly Religious Events

Coaching & IT Classes

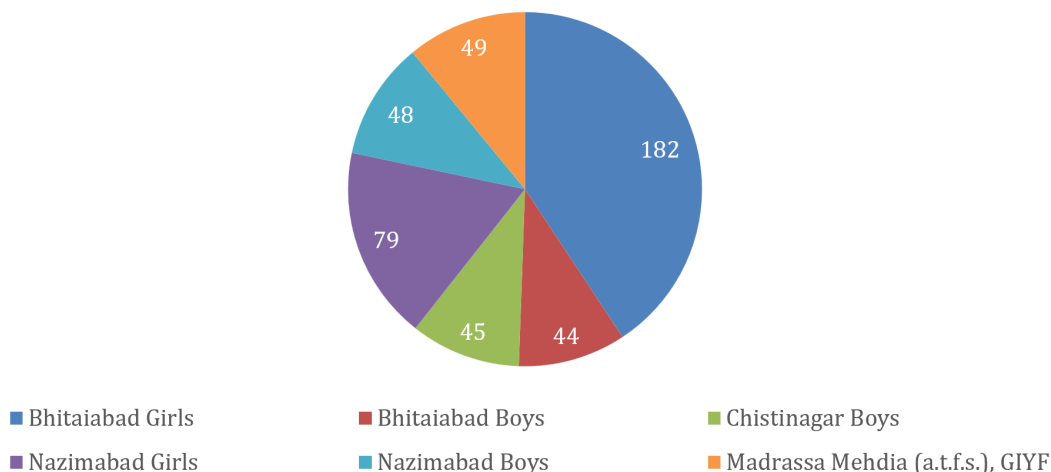
- In May, a total of 11 students were enrolled in coaching across different classes, while admissions remain open.

Green Island Online Teachings

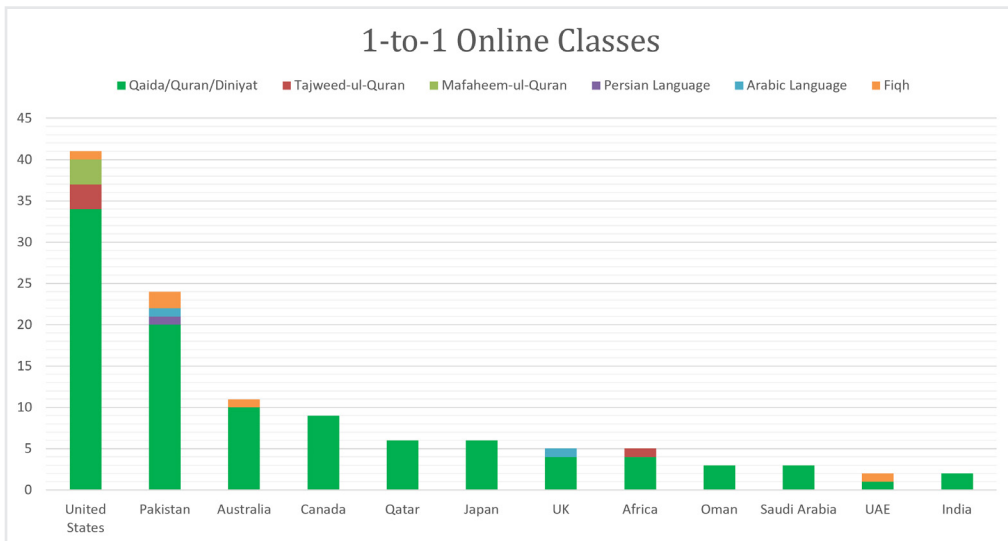

Our online platform unifies the Ummah through exceptional Islamic education, connecting believers to the Holy Quran and Ahlebait's (a.s.) wisdom.
- To date, more than **523 individuals** have completed their courses and learned the Holy Quran, **Maktab-e-Ahlebait (a.s.)** Diniyat, Tajweed, Mafaheem-ul-Quran, Fiqh, Persian, and Arabic Language.
 - Around **438** enrolled in 1-to-1 classes,
 - Over **85 students** attended group classes.
- Alhamdo Lillah, in the month of May, 3 students from Saudi Arabia, India, and the USA have enrolled in our 1-to-1 online Quran/Qaida and Diniyat courses.
- Up to May 31, we have been providing individualized online services to **117** students, both male and female, from diverse parts of the world, Alhamdo Lillah.
- GIOT announced its Summer Course, scheduled from 1st June 2026 to 30th July 2026. The classes will be conducted online via Zoom, four days a week. The course will cover **Quran, Seerat, Ikhlaiqiyat, History, Fiqh, and Duas**, and will be taught by qualified male and female teachers for both boys and girls.
